# Release

**It's a requirement for you and your parents to sign this release and rules of conduct form in order for you to attend the Three Day Confirmation Retreat.**

**We request you turn this form in no later than Sunday, July 25.**

This consent form gives permission to seek whatever medical attention is deemed necessary, and releases Vineyard® Church, know below as the Church, and its staff of any liability against personal losses of named child.

I/We the undersigned have legal custody of the youth named below, a minor, and have given our consent for him/her to attend events being organized by the Church. I/We understand that there are inherent risks involved in any ministry or athletic event, and I/we hereby release the Church, its pastors, employees, agents, and volunteer workers from any and all liability for any injury, loss, or damage to person or property that may occur during the course of my/our child's involvement. In the event that he/she is injured and requires the attention of a doctor, I/we consent to any reasonable medical treatment as deemed necessary by a licensed physician. In the event treatment is required from a physician and/or hospital personnel designated by the Church, I/we agree to hold such person free and harmless of any claims, demands, or suits for damages arising from the giving of such consent. 1. I will respect those in authority.

# What to Bring:

## Three Day Retreat (grade 7-12)

- Bible, notebook and pen
- Towel, tooth paste/brush, shampoo, comb/brush Tickle-me-Elmo
- A fun, obedient, godly, ready for a great time attitude!
- Sunscreen, sunglasses
- Casual clothes, clothes to play in (get dirty), tennis shoes, shoes you can get wet like old tennis shoes or water socks, sandals, pj's
- \$'s about 20 to 25 for four meals
- \$'s for any extra activities, souvenirs (optional)
- Water Bottle – a great idea
- Any of your medication, make your leader aware of your need to take medication (Medicine Release form required)
- Bathing Suit, must be modest! If it isn't according to leader standard you will need to wear a colored T-shirt over. Girls, this means one-piece suits.
- Be sure to bring only one reasonably sized bag (not your entire wardrobe)  
\*\*\*Remember to label your bag\*\*\*

**What not to bring:** (could result in immediate removal from event, no refunds)

- ⊗ A bad attitude
- ⊗ Shaving cream, silly string etc. (will be confiscated, if found on you, sent home)
- ⊗ Anything illegal to your age (drugs, alcohol, fireworks, cigarettes, etc.)
- ⊗ Anything potentially dangerous – knives etc.
- ⊗ Music devices, cell phones, dvd players, etc. If you choose to bring these items, be prepared to surrender them upon arrival at destination. They will be returned to you upon departure.

Use this retreat to get away from the normal things of life.

Music players, cell phones, etc. can distract from what God may want you to learn and enjoy while you are away.

## **Three Day Confirmation Retreat Scholarship Information**

Scholarships will be considered for those who submit completed registration and release forms.

The maximum scholarship amount per person is \$40 to ensure that more youth are impacted by the resources that God has provided.

Scholarships will only be offered as long as we have the financial resources to do so; we simply cannot spend what we do not have. Scholarships will be given on a "first come, first served" basis. Unfortunately, we realize this means that some who request a scholarship may not receive one.
