Have a volunteer read the following scripture:

John 14:12 (NLT):

“I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father.”

Questions

Please feel free to adjust this study to fit your group’s needs and to listen to the direction of the Holy Spirit. It is not necessary to use all of the questions.

1. If you didn’t know anything about Christianity, how would you like to be told about it?
2. What do you think or feel about the idea of telling others about Jesus?
3. Read Matthew 5: 13 – 16. Jesus calls us to be ‘salt and light’ in the world. Christians are to be in the world, seeking to influence friends, family, and work colleagues for Christ. People are more likely to listen to what we say if they can see the life-changing reality of Christ in our lives. In what ways can we be “children of light?”
4. What are some creative ways we can show God’s love?
5. Read Romans 1:16. Would one or two people care to share in 5 minutes or less the following:
 - a. What was your life like before you came to know Christ?
 - b. How did you come to know Christ?
 - c. How is your life different now that you have a personal relationship with Christ?

Ice Breaker

Use the following question to help people open up and to focus your meeting. It is very helpful to go around in a circle with the leader going first. (Remember if you have new members or guests you should take time to introduce everyone.)

Tell us of a time when you had really good news to share. What was the good news and how did you tell others?

6. Take time to pray for your nonchristian friends, relatives, associates, neighbors, and kids (F.R.A.N.K.).
